MIGHTY TREES

As I write this article a week before Christmas, there is a work crew in the church cemetery taking care of some trees damaged by lightning earlier in the summer. Unfortunately, these are not young trees, but massive oaks that have presided over our cemetery for close to one hundred years. The men had started to trim and then cut the trees when I arrived at work. After about thirty minutes there suddenly came a massive thump, shaking the building and rattling the windows. It felt like a small earthquake. It was one of the trees, falling to the ground!

All of us have known men and women who have been giants in our lives. They may have been a parent, a favorite teacher, a mentor, a family member, or a close friend. Regardless of the connection, we learned something important from them about life and relationships. They helped to guide and mold us into the people we are today. And when they passed out of our lives, a void was created, that seemed impossible to fill.

However, there is a principle in life that nature abhors voids. No matter how deep our loss, the void will be filled; hopefully by others who step forward to fill it. Which is where we come in. Just as we were guided by people we saw as giants, so must we become to others around us. As a faith community, we must be aware of those who have had their lives disrupted and voids created, and step up to help heal and make whole. Some call it a caring ministry. No matter what it is called, it is part of the relationship that binds us to each other, as members of God's family.

In the shadow of that great tree that was removed, there stands a small tree that, if left alone, will grow to take the place of the tree cut down. In a hundred years, it will be one of the giants of the Olive Branch cemetery. May we as people of faith dare to reach out as and be giants to others.






SALVATION ARMY GIFT BAGS STUFFED AND PLENTIFUL:

ABOUT THE MONTH OF JANUARY


January is a cold, dark month. It is usually the coldest month of the year here, but equivalent to July in the southern hemisphere. This first month of the year does lead to longer days, as the Winter Solstice marked the slow return of daylight on December 21st.

A number of holidays & declared special recognitions occur this month:

- 15th Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- 26th Australia Day
(celebrating the arrival of the First Fleet at Sydney Cove in 1788)
- National Book Month
- National Thank You Month
- National Eye Care Month
- Nat'l Volunteer Blood Donor Month
- National Soup Month

January's birthstone is the Garnet; its flower the carnation. The Zodiac signs coming in January are: Capricorn and Aquarius.

The name of this first month comes from the name of a Roman god, Janus. (Janus is the Roman word for door.) This God has two faces, allowing him to look into the new year and back into the past year. He often symbolized social and cultural change. Sometimes the Saxons called January the wolf month because hungry wolves would come into their towns searching for food this time of year. For a long period of European history, the start of the New Year occurred in March, since the old Roman calendar only had 10 months. (January & February were missing).


