#### WHAT CAN I DO DURING LENT?

The season of Lent begins on February 14, the day we call Ash Wednesday. Lent is a period of 40 days, not counting Sundays, that ends on the day before Easter. Over the last several years we have observed Lent in community with our ecumenical brothers and sisters, traveling each week to one of the member churches of our Upper James City County Ministerial. This year, Olive Branch will host the Ash Wednesday Service. Rev. Lori Beach of Mt. Vernon UMC will be our speaker.

Lent is a season that is traditionally seen as a time for self-reflection and fasting. However, it is also a good time for working on other spiritual disciplines. It is a good time to focus upon prayer, especially praying that our Lenten journey will bring us closer to Christ. It is a good time to work on discipline, in particular personal discipline, related to our physical and mental exercises. It's a good time to look within and discover aspects of ourselves that are less than Christ-like and letting them die. It's a good time to simplify our ambitions and focus upon that which is of true importance. It is a good time to acknowledge our weaknesses and seek God's help. It is a good time to resist the temptation to give into anger and frustration, and instead practice the love that God in Christ has shown to us. It's a good time to practice charity, by reaching out to and helping others. Ultimately, it is a good time to learn to love like Christ, as we journey with him to the cross on Good Friday.

I am glad we are walking together.
